Monster Eye Sensory Counting Game



Sensory bags are so much fun! They are soothing to touch and help children to explore new textures. This Halloween-themed sensory bag also helps children to know number names, counting sequences, and understand the relationship between numbers and quantities.

Ingredients:

The eyeless monster template
2 Gallon-sized freezer bags
Clear hair gel
Glitter
Googly eyes

Recipe:

- Fill one-gallon size ziplock bag with hair gel.
- Place 45 small googly eyes and glitter inside ziplock with gel and seal.
- Place the ziplock back with hair gel inside the second ziplock bag and seal.
- Flip the eyes over so that child can see them.
- Print the pdf monster template.
- Place the monster template underneath the ziplock bags.
- Help your child move the appropriate amount of eyes to each monster.
- Help your child to identify each number.
- Practice counting up to 10 with your child and down to 1 while moving the eyes to each monster.
